Strategic Plan Report: Our five-year plan was approved at the May Annual Members meeting. At the June Board meeting, we began the process of setting goals in each of these key areas:

Finance Report:

Scholar Awards increased this past year to \$165, 000 (up from previous year of \$145,000). Our fund balance has all the money necessary to cover all 33 current awards through the three years of the awards. Income for this past year, however, is down from last year (though June 2015 has not ended yet). A full discussion regarding the budget for 2015-2016, and goals needing to be met, followed. The board approved this preliminary budget.
